

	Resolve resource issues across projects	* Expand XDPP or create something else to provide a forum for this discussion  * Encourage individual discussions between PMs  * SAIS Finance is looking at resource tools that might be used elsewhere within IS&T	* Help to ensure project success by reducing resource conflicts and addressing cross-directorate project issues
Performance Measurement / Project Management Support	Manager (and IS&T) support for PM activites	* Proj Mgr identifies required PM components and obtains manager buy-in  * Allocate time for PM skill building (e.g., negotiation, leading by influence)  * Provide relevant PM training to IS&T managers  * On large projects, avoid multitasking project managers (not PM+BA+QA, etc.)	* Allows PMs to engage in PM activities appropriately, and with support * Focuses PMs on PM tasks * Note: CMM would not be useful now
Project Management Support	Establish IS&T PM Community of Practice (CoP)	* Schedule regular PM meetings with a small group of experienced PMs	* Talk and Learn  * Identify Common PM Building Blocks  * Develop IS&T Methodology from existing functional area models  * Build a template repository
	Post Project Reviews and Acknowledgement of a job well done	* Implement post project reviews	* Highlight positives and areas for improve * Share Results
	Coach/Mentor Junior PMs	* Leverage the "senior" PMs as coaches/mentors for junior PMs	* Increase the probability of success by providing advice, perspective, and a "safe" place to get answers
	Community Education on PM	* Educate the client community about the role/value of PM	* Allows PMs to focus on the PM activities
