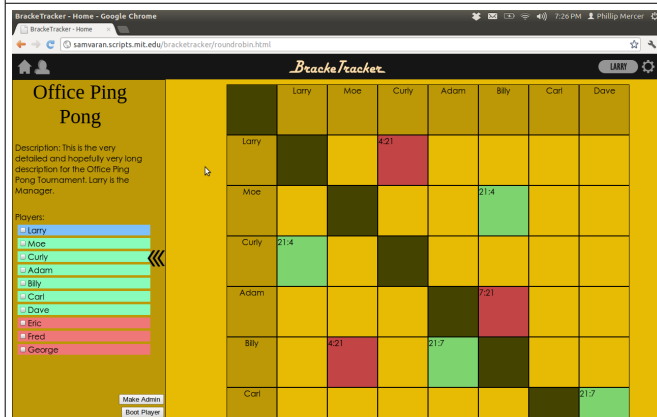


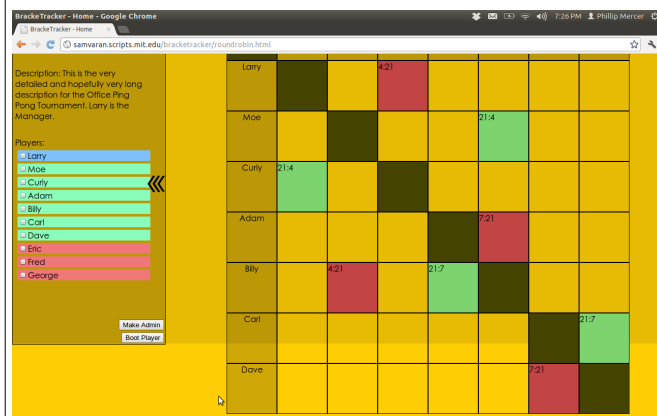
I really like the design of the site. You picked a good color scheme with colors that don't clash and are not a strain on the eyes. Also, I don't see any issues for users that are color blind. I also like the header of the page. The icons are intuitive and balanced.

I like the "+" on the "Create Tournament" button, however as it is currently implemented the "+" overlaps some of the text. This is only a cosmetic change.



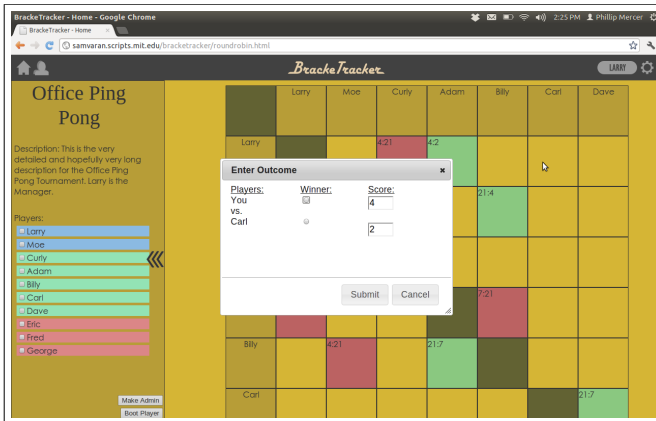
I like that you are able to expand and collapse the list of players. The arrows are consistent with this feature. A minor cosmetic change would be to move the arrows to the right some more as it currently overlaps part of the players boxes.

There is a safety issue with the player list. The actions for the players, make admin and boot player, are hard to reverse. I can imagine a situation where you might make a player an admin and later wish to remove these rights. The only way to do this would be to boot the player. On a similar note, you are able to make booted players admins.



There is a major issue with visibility. There is no scrollbar for the page. Both the images to the left are of the round robin page, however the bottom image is scrolled down by clicking and dragging so that I could see further down the page. As you can see, Dave's entire row is hidden from view without scrolling.

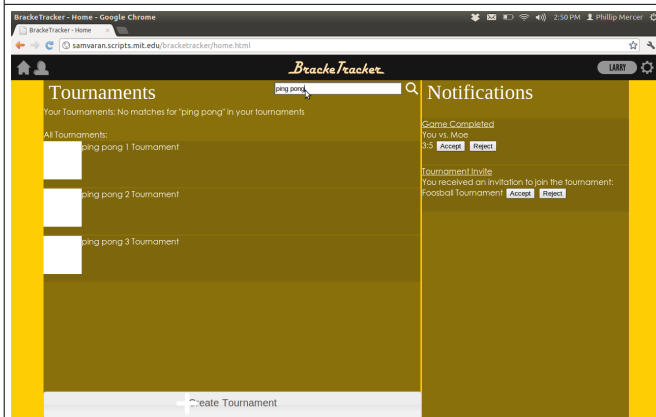
There is a slight issue with internal consistency here as well. As you can see, the background color changes once you get below the player pane.



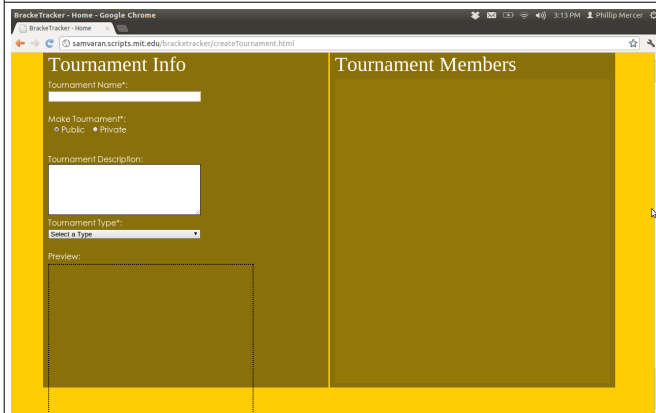
I like the score input. It is minimalist and intuitive.

One minor issue is that the input to the score fields are persistent. That is, I updated the match between Larry and Adam to be 4:2 and when I went to update the score between Larry and Carl the score fields still showed 4:2.

There is also an issue with error prevention. The user is able to mark themselves as the winner and put a losing score. The system acknowledges only the input to the radio buttons and reflects this situation as a win when the user actually lost.



The “Your Tournaments” text and the “No matches” text are on the same line. It would be more consistent, both internally and externally, if the “No matches” text was placed on a new line.



A slight cosmetic issue on this page is the fact the preview portion extends past the Tournament Info pane and into the lighter colored background.

I am assuming the asterisks indicate required fields. This is good in that it is consistent with other forms, however I believe that it would still be good to inform the user of this.

The popup to invite members also has an issue with learnability. The user types in the names of the people they are to invite to the tournament. However, they are not informed as to what character to use to separate names.
